**1<sup>st</sup> UNIBO International  
New Rose Trials**

**29 May 2021**



In The 1<sup>st</sup> UNIBO International New Rose Trials, 54 hybrids of the 2021 competition and 48 hybrids of the 2020 postponed competition due to coronavirus, were evaluated in the Rose Garden by a local Jury on the 29<sup>th</sup> May 2021 and by an International Jury evaluating roses online, by photos.

The local jury consisted of 25 experts, that is 5 nurserymen specialized in the production of rose plants, 5 landscapers, 4 experts working in the Rose Garden, 4 researchers on ornamental plants of the University of Bologna, 2 technicians for urban and public parks, 4 representatives of local hobby gardening societies and one perfumer.

The International digital Jury included 4 judges of the WFRS and 4 Italian experts, despite photos being sent to more connoisseurs.

The maximum score achievable by each hybrid is 100, so obtained:

General Impression: 30 points (plant habitus, foliage, vigor, novelty)

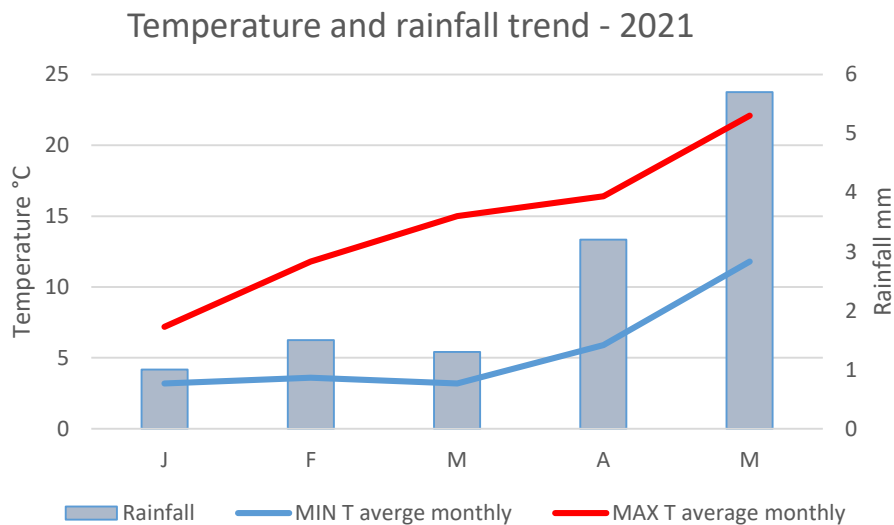
Flower: 30 points (flower shape, color, abundance, novelty)

Disease resistance: 30 points (fungal diseases, pest tolerance)

Fragrance: 10 points




Monthly average temperature and rainfall trends in the in the Rose Garden are shown below. The minimum temperature resulted below 0 °C for 7, 4, 5 and 2 days in January, February, March and April, respectively. March was unusually warm but rainfall was very low throughout the period.

Plants were pruned in late February.
